Dear Parishioner,
Every two years, the members of St. Nicholas Albanian Orthodox Church elect a new Parish Council, the governing board of our church. It is time to elect the Parish Council for the two-year 2024-2025 term. The election will take place on Sunday, November 26, 2023, in the church hall immediately following Divine Liturgy.

In order to vote, you must be a regular member in good standing and not be delinquent in the payment of dues. You must be present to cast your vote – absentee ballots are not allowed under our church constitution. Honorary members are also not eligible to vote however they are welcome to attend the meeting. Ballots will be handed out to eligible voting members on November 26, 2023.

Anyone interested in running for a seat on the Parish Council should fill out the nomination form. Nominations will not be accepted after that date since a ballot must be prepared for the election on November 26, 2023. No nominations from the floor will be accepted on the day of the election.

According to the church constitution candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Candidates must be twenty-one (21) years of age or older and of Albanian extraction or descent OR the spouse of a person of Albanian extraction or descent. Candidates must be baptized according to the rites of the Eastern Orthodox Church, and able to provide proof of baptism if asked.
- Must have been a regular member of St. Nicholas Church in good standing for a minimum of six (6) months and not be delinquent in the payment of church dues.
- Must attend Sunday Divine Liturgy on a regular basis and give of time and talents to the smooth operation of the church.



Të dashur anëtarë të Kishës,
Cdo dy vjet anëtarët e Kishës Shqiptare Ortodokse të Shën Nikolles zgjedhin një këshill të ri të Kishës. Është koha për të zgjedhur Këshillin e Kishës për periudhën dy-vjecare 2024-2025. Zgjedhjet do të zhvillohen të dielë më 26 Nentor, 2023, në hollin e kishës menjëherë pas Liturgjisë Hyjnore.

Për të votuar ju duhet të jeni anëtar i kishës që i keni përmbushur tërë detyrimet dhe keni bërë pagesat e anëtarësisë në kohë. Ju duhet të jeni të pranishëm për të votuar, votimi në mungesë nuk lejohet në bazë të kushtetutës së kishës. Anëtarët e nderit "honorary" gjithashtu nuk mund të votojnë, megjithatë ata janë të mirëpritur të ndjekin mbledhjen. Fletvotimet do tu jepen vetëm anëtarëve me të drejta votimi më 26 Nentor 2023.

Të gjithë formularët duhet të dorëzohen ose të dërgohen brenda datës 19 Nentor, 2023. Pas kësaj date nuk do të pranohen me kandidatura për t'i dhënë këshillit të votimeve kohe të mjaftueshme të krijoje fletvotimet për zgjedhjet e 26 nentorit. Nuk do të lejohet gjithashtu kandidatura nga të pranishmit në ditën e votimit.

Sipas kushtetutës së kishës kandidatët duhet të plotësojnë kushtet e mëposhtme:

- Kandidati duhet të jetë 21 (njëzet e një) vjet ose më i madh, me origjinë/prejardhje Shqipëtare ose të jetë i martuar me një person të prejardhjes shqipëtare.. Kandidatët duhet të jenë pagëzuar sipas riteve të Kishës Ortodokse të Lindjes, dhe duhet të paraqesin dokumentin e pagëzimit në rast se ju kërkohet.
- Duhet të ketë qenë anëtar i rregullt i kishës së Shen Nikolles për të paktën 6 (gjashtë) muaj dhe të ketë bërë pagesat në kohë.
- Duhet të ndjekë Liturgjinë Hyjnore të së Dielës rregullisht dhe të kontribuojë kohë dhe talent për mbarëvajtjen e kishës.

Just follow these simple steps:

1. If you would like to participate, send an email to the church (church@stnicholasalbanianchicago.org) or to Sofia Panajoti (jonasimeon@hotmail.com). Your name will be added to our donor list.
2. A foster child's Wish List will be assigned to each participant. The Wish List includes the child's name, age and items they would like to receive.
3. The Wish List for your assigned foster child can be picked up in the church hall after Sunday Liturgy from Sofia Panajoti. Or, if you prefer, the Wish List can be sent to you via email or text. Let us know your preference when you sign up to participate. If you choose to receive a text, please include your phone number.
4. Review your foster child's Wish List and, if you would like, involve your own family in selecting an appropriate gift for your assigned foster child.
5. **OPTIONAL:** Choose a Christmas card to enclose with your gift and write a friendly message to your foster child, Sign the Christmas card only with your first name.
6. All gifts must be new and unwrapped. Please put your gift in a gift bag together with your foster child's Wish List and optional Christmas card. **Use gift bags – do not wrap gifts with wrapping paper.** Tissue paper in the bags is okay to use, If you are giving a gift card, it should be placed in a box so as not to get easily lost.
7. Bring your gift bags to church by **Sunday, November 26.** **Gift bags will not be accepted after this deadline.**

INSTALLATION CEREMONY



We are honored to announce that on Saturday, October 14, 2023 the Installation Ceremony of His Grace Bishop Theophan of Philomelion was held at St. Nicholas Albanian Orthodox Church. This ceremony is a liturgical rite by which a ruling bishop is installed in his cathedral. This is when he officially began to oversee his diocese. Archbishop Elidophoros presided with other members of the clergy in attendance. Having this ceremony take place at St. Nicholas was a great honor for our church. A luncheon reception followed in our hall. Bishop Theophan was born in 1966 in Tirana, Albania. He graduated from the College Economic School in 1985 and served two years in the Albanian Army.

In 1991, he graduated from the Academy of Economic Sciences in Tirana and proceeded to serve the Albanian government as an Economics Inspector in the Department of State Controls from 1991-1992.

From February through July 1992, he studied Orthodox Theology in Durres with the first group of students under the tutelage of then Father Ilia Katre. Between 1992 and 1998, he participated in numerous local and international conferences, sometimes representing the Albanian Orthodox Archdiocese (OCA) or the Church of Romania.

In September of 1993, at the invitation of Patriarch Theoctist of Romania, he departed to study at the Orthodox Theological Institute of Bucharest under the tutelage of Archbishop Calinic of Arges. He was ordained a Deacon on January 1, 1995 and tonsured a monastic five days, later the Feast of the Theophany. He took the name Theophan.

In May of 1995, he was ordained a priest and elevated to the rank of archimandrite. In September, he graduated from the theological school and began two years of service as a missionary priest in Bucharest. From 1995-1999, he pursued a doctoral degree in theology at the University of Bucharest. At the beginning of 1995, he was also appointed abbot of the Aninoasa Monastery in Curtea de Arges.

In 1995, the Church of Romania released him to the Romanian Episcopate (OCA), where he served as rector of St. Thomas the Apostle parish in St. Louis, until August 2021. He was then assigned to Boston, where he was rector of St. George Albanian Orthodox Cathedral. In June 2023, he was incardinated



in the Ecumenical Patriarchate. Following his meeting in Constantinople with His All Holiness Patriarch Bartholomew, Father Theophan was proposed by His Holiness to the Holy and Sacred Synod of the Ecumenical Patriarchate for the election as new Bishop of Philomelion, succeeding Metropolitan Ilia who reposed in the Lord on October 6, 2022.



On July 25, 2023, Archimandrite Theophan was consecrated as the bishop for the Albanian Diocese of America. Archbishop Elidophoros presided at the service held at St. George Patriarchal Cathedral in Constantinople.

Bishop Theophan is fluent in Albanian, Romanian, English, Greek, Italian, and Macedo Romanian (Aromanian). He holds Albanian, Romanian and American citizenship.

NATIVITY FAST

PERIOD The Orthodox Christian practice of fasting is designed to be a spiritual discipline. By fasting from foods, that is not eating certain foods such as animal products and of course eating less, we are willingly putting a limit on ourselves and our appetite. The result is that we become very

conscience of our physical state which transfers to our spiritual condition. In other words our body helps to sharpen our spiritual senses. We are able to show self-control, first by being aware of what and how much we eat and then we are vigilant in our self-control as to what we think, say and do.

In anticipation of the Nativity in the flesh of our Lord God and Savior Jesus Christ, the Church ordains a 40 days fast period from November 15 to December 24. We use this time period to pray, to think about our existence, to make corrections in our behavior and to make our life Christ centered. Let us pray to God to grant us a worthy Advent, to help us make changes in ourselves and to prepare us to receive the Christ child in humility, praise and thanksgiving.

THANKSGIVING DAY The American Nation observes the last Thursday in November as Thanksgiving Day. Its purpose is for us to remember to give thanks to God for the abundant blessings we enjoy as a people and a Nation. Let us be mindful of all that we have and enjoy but also let us remember those in need and poverty in our prayers. Let us set aside from our financial and material resources help for the poor. A contribution to St. Nicholas Needy Fund, or IOCC or some charity that offers food and clothing is an appropriate way to observe real Thanksgiving. To share with others is pleasing to the Lord Who said "...give to the poor and you will have treasure in heaven..." (Mt. 19:21)

Cosmas and Damianos the Holy Unmercenaries and their mother Theodota

ANARGJENDËT KOZMA E DAMIAN

of Asia Minor

**Commemorated on
November 1st**

The Holy Wonderworkers and Unmercenary Physicians Cosmas and Damian and their mother Saint Theodota were natives of Asia Minor (some sources say Mesopotamia). Their pagan father died while they were still quite small children. Their mother raised them in Christian piety. Through her own example, and by reading holy books to them, Saint Theodota preserved her children in purity of life according to the command of the Lord, and Cosmas and Damian grew up into righteous and virtuous men. Trained and skilled as physicians, they received from the Holy Spirit the gift of healing people's illnesses of body and soul by the power of prayer. They even treated animals. With fervent love for both God and neighbor, they never took payment for their services.

They strictly observed the command of our Lord Jesus Christ, *"Freely have you received, freely give."* (Mt. 10:8). The fame of Saints Cosmas and Damian spread throughout all the surrounding region, and people called them



unmercenary physicians. Once, the saints were summoned to a grievously ill woman named Palladia, whom all the doctors had refused to treat because of her seemingly hopeless condition. Through faith and through the fervent prayer of the holy brothers, the Lord healed the deadly disease and Palladia got up from her bed perfectly healthy and

giving praise to God. In gratitude for being healed and wishing to give them a small gift, Palladia went quietly to Damian. She presented him with three eggs and said, "Take this small gift in the Name of the Holy Life-Creating Trinity, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit." Hearing the Name of the Holy Trinity, the unmercenary one did not dare to refuse.

When Saint Cosmas learned what had happened, became very sad, for he thought that his brother had broken their strict vow. On his deathbed he gave instructions that his brother should not be buried beside him. Saint Damian also died shortly afterward, and everyone wondered where Saint Damian's grave should be. But through the will of God a miracle occurred. A camel, which the saints had treated for its wildness, spoke with a human voice

saying that they should have no doubts about whether to place Damian beside Cosmas, because Damian did not accept the eggs from the woman as payment, but out of respect for the Name of God. The venerable relics of the holy brothers were buried together at Thereman (Mesopotamia).

Many miracles were worked after the death of the holy unmercenaries. There lived at Thereman, near the church of Cosmas and Damian, a certain man by the name of Malchus. One day he went on a journey, leaving his wife all alone for what would be a long time. He prayerfully entrusted her to the heavenly protection of the holy brothers. But the Enemy of the race of mankind took on the appearance of one of Malchus' friends, and planned to kill the woman. A certain time went by, and this man went to her at home and said that Malchus had sent him to bring her to him. The woman believed him and went along. He led her to a solitary place intending to kill

disaster threatened her, called upon God with deep faith.

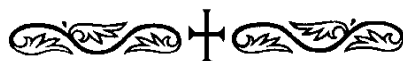
Two fiercesome men then appeared, and the devil let go of the woman and fled, falling off a cliff. The two men led the woman home. At her own home, bowing to them deeply she asked, "My rescuers, to whom I shall be grateful to the end of my days, what are your names?" They replied, "We are the servants of Christ, Cosmas and Damian," and became invisible. The woman with trembling and with joy told everyone about what had happened to her. Glorifying God, she went up to the icon of the holy brothers and tearfully offered prayers of thanksgiving for her deliverance. And from that time the holy brothers were venerated as protectors of the holiness and inviolability of Christian marriage, and as givers of harmony to conjugal life.

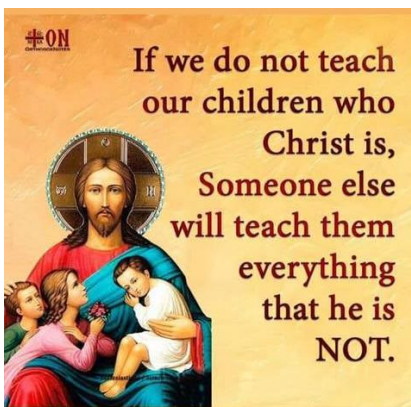
We are excited to see the kids thriving and enjoying the Albanian Independence festivities.

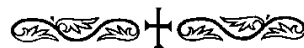

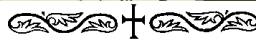
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
